#### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The organisers / committee of the West Plantagenet Pony Club reserve the right to cancel, alter or combine any event/s they may deem necessary on the day. Ribbons and prize money will not be given out until the ring is completed and packed away. The judges' decisions are final. Under no circumstances is approaching the judge, judging, or coaching from the side of the arena / ring permitted. Failure to abide by this rule will lead to disqualification and forfeit of entry fees.
2. PCAWA rules apply for this event.
3. All riders must either be financial PCWA members or must have paid their PC Annual Insurance Fee & have signed the insurance disclaimer statement online when signing up to PCWA/Pony Club.
4. No Dogs on the grounds.
5. **ALL competitors will require a helper.** It is up to the riders to make sure that their helper knows what they are doing and at what time. Helper to report to the clubrooms to advise they are available for duty & also once they have completed the duty.
6. West Plantagenet Pony Club and its committee, judges, and PCWA DO NOT accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, illness or injury to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. Entry to grounds is at your own risk.
7. Each horse can enter three classes **ONE** A and B and C; however, they may change heights between each class, but must only enter only **one A and B and C**. Take Your Own Line is an optional class and height will depend on how many competitors in each class on the day. Competitors in leading rein and first ridden are encouraged to only enter the 30cm height classes.
8. 30cm & 45cm classes will commence first at 8.30am and presentations for these classes will commence upon completion of these two classes.
9. Photos – PCWA Approved Photographers will be attending. Please advise the Photographer or our WPPC Committee should you not wish to have your photo taken or published.  
It is the member's responsibility to inform Event Organisers in writing if they DO NOT wish to be photographed by the official event photographers at least 48 hours prior to the event.  
Photographers acting in a professional capacity at Pony Club WA events must be approved as per our Visual Images Policy (available on our website [www.pcawa.com](http://www.pcawa.com)).  
Individuals, please review the PCWA Member Protection Policy v5 & Visual Images Policy before considering the taking of photos or video at Pony Club events.
